

Measuring instructions caps & ferrules

We have a large selection of caps and ferrules on our website. But how do you determine the right cap size? Under the saying 'to measure is to know', we will show you step by step how to determine the correct cap size.

TIPS

- 1. Preferably always measure the tube or the furniture legs and not the cap or ferrule itself. Measuring the cap itself can give an incorrect measured value!
- 2. Always carry out precise measurements in millimeters, preferably using a caliper gauge.

Measuring instructions step by step

The correct size of the cap depends on the **<u>outer tube size</u>**. In this example, we will measure the outer size of the tube or furniture leg:

1. Measure the outer dimensions in millimeters using a caliper gauge or a ruler (Fig. 1)

2. Now that the size of the tube is clear, you can use the filters on our website to select the measured tube size ('Tube size'). After filtering, you will be presented with a selection of caps and ferrules that are suitable for the tube or furniture leg in question.
